

Justin Carter - Brief Biography

Following graduation from the MFA programme at Glasgow School of Art, Justin Carter was selected for New Contemporaries 2000. Later that year he took up the inaugural residency at Cove Park, showing work at Tramway, Glasgow.

He has exhibited work throughout the UK and abroad including a special commission for the 2004 Whitstable Biennale where he gifted free produce from his solar powered ice-cream stall along the East Kent coast. Most recently he produced a new prototype of this device for the 2005 Expo' in Japan.

Since 2003 he has taught in the Department of Sculpture and Environmental Art at Glasgow School of Art where he is developing cross-school projects related to sustainability, ecology and art. He is currently developing work for the Stavanger Biennale 2008 as well as researching possibilities for art and ecology for Gunpowder Park with a 'Bright Sparks' fellowship.
